In October 2022, the Street Child Football **World Cup** will take place in Doha. A team of 10 girls from Bangladesh have secured a place to take part. There will be 8 girls' teams from different countries taking part in the tournament.

Sponsoring a child

Street Children Leedo is the organisation in Bangladesh that is supporting the girls who will take part in the tournament. These are girls who were abandoned by their parents. Some were forced into domestic service. others were abused and survived by sleeping at the launch terminal in Dhaka or the railway stations. They are now living at LEEDO's long-term Peace Home for children who were on the streets. They are attending local schools. Taking part in the tournament will empower the girls and enable them to become positive role models for other street-connected children.

A WORLD-CLASS EVENT HELD IN DOHA, QATAR FOR THE WORLD'S MOST VULNERABLE

We are seeking sponsors who will help children supported by LEEDO on their journey from the streets to taking up opportunities such as participation in the Street Child Football World Cup.

Sponsorship of £100 provides one month of funding for a worker on the streets of Dhaka, contacting and rescuing children surviving on the streets.

Sponsorship of £250 is the typical cost of a child staying at a transitional shelter before rehabilitation with their family or moving to long term care including at LEEDO's Peace Home

Sponsorship of £500 enables children at LEEDO Peace Home to realise their potential by funding classes such as football, cricket, art, music, and computing for one year.

All sponsors will hear directly from children taking part in the Street Child Football World Cup about how this opportunity has transformed their lives.

About LEEDO

LEEDO have been working with children on the streets of Dhaka since 2010. They are a registered Non-Government Organisation with the NGO Affairs Bureau of the office of the Prime Minister of Bangladesh (Registration number 1466).

They provide outreach work, food, health support, counselling, and education to children on the street. They run 2 transitional shelters supporting children to find long-term care with their families or other Government/NGO services. They run a long-term "Peace Home" for 70 children with no other options, including many children with disabilities and special needs. The girls taking part in the football tournament are living at the Peace Home.
